We need people who enjoy being out and about, working flexible hours (including some evenings and weekends), comfortable and happy to call on people at home, can quickly build rapport and who are experienced in communicating with people from different walks of life.

Background information

CBG Health Research Limited is currently completing field work for the New Zealand Health Survey (NZHS) on behalf of the Ministry of Health. The 8-year project is currently in its 6th year of administration. The NZHS replaces a number of health monitoring surveys previously commissioned by the Ministry of Health. The new NZHS started in April 2011. It is a face to face household survey lasting approximately one hour for adults and half an hour for children. The survey involves around 18,000 households per annum with the completion of approximately 350 surveys per week. It requires the return of high quality data and has consistently delivered a response rate of 80%.

An advance letter is sent prior to the interviewer's visit, inviting householders to take part and advising of the interviewer's impending visit. The sample is pre-drawn and each area has approximately 23 households selected ready for the interviewer to approach. Enumeration from scratch is not required, however interviewers need to check that all houses are listed and add any ones that are missing. There is the potential to get a survey at every house visited, and if there are children at a house, one will be randomly selected for invitation - approximately one house in three.

Remuneration for NZHS is based on the number of valid surveys completed each week:

- \$ rate per completed survey
- \$ rate per completed area (includes completing call backs and enumeration check- that no houses have been left out)
- Mileage paid at 75c per km for the first 50km travelled per week, and then 50c per km thereafter

Background information

CBG Public Sector Surveying is currently completing field work for the New Zealand Household Travel Survey (NZHTS) on behalf of the Ministry of Transport. The 5-year project is currently in its 2nd year of administration. The NZHTS collects information about the day-to-day travel in New Zealand – such as how, where and when we travel. The results provide a picture of travel patterns and choices of all types of people – information which is vital for developing transport policy including road safety, public transport, walking and cycling. Since October 2015 CBG has been undertaking the new continuous travel survey using GPS technology and online forms. The survey involves around 2700 households per annum with approximately 100 households recruited to take part each week.

An advance letter is sent prior to the interviewer's visit, inviting householders to take part and advising of the interviewer's impending visit. The sample is pre-drawn and each area has approximately 13 households selected ready for the interviewer to approach. Enumeration from scratch is not required, however interviewers need to check that all houses are listed and add any ones that are missing. There is no screening for eligibility, therefore the potential to get a household recruited at every one you visit. You will not be conducting an interview, you will be recruiting the household to take part and setting them up with GPS devices.

Remuneration for NZHTS is based on the number of valid households recruited each week:

- \$ rate per recruited household
- Mileage paid at 75c per km for the first 50km travelled per week, and then 50c per km thereafter
- Travel time paid at \$ rate per hour for travel to and from the meshblock
- Bonuses are available for excellent response rates and data quality

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
